

NYS Award Information Sheet Changes for 2022-23

- All the Changes to the College Financing Plan for 2022-23 will be incorporated into the New York State Award Information Sheet (NYS-AIS).
- The Supplemental Page will be added that includes the Graduation Rate, Loan Default Rate, Median Borrowing and Estimated Costs for Additional Years in the Program.

Full Elimination of the TAP Gap for 2022-23

• The 2021-22 Enacted budget phased in general fund operating support for the cost of the TAP Gap over three years as follows:

```
2022-23 (33%)
2023-24 (67%)
2024-25 (100%)
```

• The 2022-23 Enacted budget fully eliminates the TAP Gap in the 2022-23 year by providing direct state tax support.

Full Elimination of the TAP Gap for 2022-23

• Fiscal change from Institutions funding the TAP Gap to the State funding the SUNY Tuition Credit.

Accelerate the Excelsior Scholarship Tuition Rate "Re-Set"

- The 2021-22 Enacted budget stated the undergraduate tuition charged by the institution to Excelsior recipients shall not exceed the academic year 2016-17 tuition rate through the 2023-24 academic year (formerly 2021-22) and can be reset to the tuition rate established for subsequent AY year every year thereafter (previously every 4 years thereafter).
- The 2022-23 Enacted budget accelerated the reset to the 2022-23 academic year.

Accelerate the Excelsior Scholarship Tuition Rate "Re-Set"

- Changes affect the Student Status Listing Awarding Process, ROPYSSL.
- Eliminate the Excelsior Cohort applied by the ROPYSSL process starting with 2022-23.
- Use Current Tuition Rate starting with 2022-23 for Excelsior and Excelsior Tuition Credit Calculations which are calculated by the ROPYSSL process.

Expand the TAP Program to Part-Time Students

- Students taking six-or-more credits at a SUNY, CUNY, or non-proprietary independent college in approved courses would be eligible for a pro-rated TAP award.
- Includes Part-time TAP awards to a community college student enrolled in an approved non-degree workforce credential program.
- Prior Part-Time TAP eligibility:
 - first-time freshman in the 2006-07 academic year or thereafter
 - have earned 12 credits or me each of two consecutive semesters
 - and maintain a "C" average

Expand the TAP Program to Part-Time Students

• Changes affect the TAP Estimator process, RPEYTAP, and the State Award Certification process, SORYTCE, used to calculate Part-Time TAP eligibility.

Restore TAP Awards for Incarcerated Individuals

- Reinstate to the TAP Program the provision that was removed in 1995-96, that allows for incarcerated individuals to be eligible for TAP awards starting in 2022-23.
